## **Study Abroad Fees**

### Faculty Led Study Abroad

Faculty-Led programs allow MSU students to participate in a study abroad program led by MSU professors. These short-term programs either offer MSU credit or transfer credit and take place during the summer or other breaks. These options change from year to year.

### Fees per student

- \$300 Administrative Fee
- Insurance Fee

### Provider Led Study Abroad

Provider companies offer study abroad programs in a wide variety of locations and during all terms. Students from all over the U.S. participate in these programs and receive transfer credit for the courses they take. Prices typically include excursions to other locations, and all costs are paid directly to the company. Refer to the Study Abroad website for specific programs through MSU's affiliated provider companies.

# **Exchange Programs**

Exchange programs allow students to spend anywhere from a semester to a full year interacting with other students from around the world at a university in a different country. Academic credits transfer back to MSU and students pay their regular tuition to MSU.

## Non-credit International Student Group Travel

#### Effective 07-01-2021

All student group international travel must be registered through the Office of Study Abroad for risk management purposes. The Office of Study Abroad will create a program specific 'application' through our online software in which all student participants will have to complete various requirements including: Risk and Release, Health Information questionnaire, Emergency Contact Information, and Passport Information. In addition to the online application, students are required to participate in an Outbound Orientation. We prefer to do this orientation in-person for the entire group, but in some instances, an online orientation is made available. OSA will purchase international health and evacuation insurance for all travelers (students, faculty, and staff) and enroll all U.S. citizens in the Department of State's Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP). OSA will request necessary information for faculty/staff travelers for insurance and STEP purposes closer to departure date.

### Fees per student

- 29 or less student travelers = \$200 Administrative Fee + insurance cost
- 30-49 student travelers = \$150 Administrative Fee + insurance cost
- 50+ student travelers = \$125 Administrative Fee + insurance cost
