#### **Veterinary Medical Technology Degree Information**

- The pre-requisite phase consists of the freshman and/or sophomore years of college. The curriculum consists of the university core curriculum required for a bachelor's degree plus additional specific science and other listed courses.
- The technology phase consists of pre-clinical courses and labs during the junior year and clinical rotations during the senior year.

Applicants accepted into the pre-admission program must maintain a GPA of at least 2.5 with no grade less than "C" in any prerequisite course and complete no less than 18 semester hours each semester. If the pre-admitted student fails to meet these requirements, the student will loose their pre-admitted status. The dismissed student may apply through the normal application process to the junior year of the program. Applicants accepted into the pre-admission program are encouraged to enroll in an additional course (in addition to the prerequisite course) each semester in an area of their interest. This allows students to be in progress toward a different degree program should the need arise. Related programs include:
