Community Veterinary Services

The purpose of Community Veterinary Services is to provide a teaching environment for primary care/first opinion cases which closely simulates a high quality private veterinary practice. Emphasis will be placed on preventative medicine. Diagnostic care for patients will be provided as well.

- 1. Primary care services are available to small animal companion species.
- 2. Boarding services are available to the enrolled patient on an appointment basis.
- 3. Cases are seen by appointment, Monday through Friday.
- 4. Although attending clinicians are ultimately responsible for the patient's health, the student is expected to take advantage of the opportunity to participate in the delivery of high quality medicine and client communication while managing a fast pace, high volume case load.
