PARKING

ACCORING TO MSU AND CVM POLICY:

All students parking on MSU property must follow parking guidelines according the Student Affairs OP 91.307 in addition to the following CVM specific Wise Center policies:

- 1. CVM 6.1.12 Animal Health Center Parking
- 2. CVM 4.07 Southwest Entrance/Parking Decals
- 3. CVM 1.18 Gate Access and Compound Parking

ADDITIONALLY, SPECIFIC TO THE ANIMAL HEALTH CENTER:

Parking is allowed along the street and front parking lots in the designated spaces (Open Parking Permit). The southwest parking lot is also available for parking. **Only clients of the Animal Health Center** are allowed to park in the client marked reserved spaces. If you are a client of the AHC, and a student, faculty member, or staff of the college, you may park in a client slot until you have admitted your animal. Once the animal is admitted, you must move your vehicle. You may return your vehicle to client parking to pick up your animal at the time of discharge. (No Exceptions.) Violators will be ticketed.
