## STUDENT OWNED PETS

## According to CVM 6.1.11:

Faculty, Staff and Student owned pets are not allowed in the Animal Health Center or in the rear parking lot EXCEPT AS PATIENTS. Animals should be brought through the Admissions area of the hospital and the proper paperwork completed. No animals should enter or exit the Wise Complex through the southwest entrance or the Dean's entrance. This includes caged birds, reptiles, pocket pets, dogs, cats, etc. No animals may be kept in offices or other non-designated areas of the building.

## Additionally, specific to CVM students:

Abuse of the policy may be considered a breach of student conduct and reported to the MSU CVM Academic Affairs Office.
