RABIES PROPHYLAXIS POLICY

Per CVM 55.7.20, the College of Veterinary Medicine requires rabies prophylaxis vaccination series for all DVM and Veterinary Technology students at the student's expense. The Mississippi State University Student Health Center offers the vaccination series by appointment. Documentation verifying rabies vaccination series is required prior to the first day of class for the spring semester, freshman year.

The only exemption to this requirement is a written statement from a physician documenting anaphylactic reaction to the specific vaccine or to components of the vaccine.
