College facilities were not designed for the casual handling of personal animals. Accordingly, entrance of animals into the CVM complex is limited as follows:

- 1. Personal companion animals being admitted to the Animal Health Center (AHC) may be brought into the AHC through the AHC entrance.
- 2. Personal companion animals being brought into the college for classroom purposes may be brought in through the AHC entrance or under the direct supervision of responsible faculty member.
- 3. All animals brought into the complex MUST be under control by placing on a leash or confined to an appropriate carrier.
- 4. Animals brought into the complex must be IMMEDIATELY taken to appropriate animal facilities.
- 5. Equine or production animals must enter the complex by gaining access to the rear compound and being admitted to the AHC through the appropriate portal.
