## **Technical Standards for VMT Students**

After VMT students have been accepted into the program, a letter explaining technical standards will be sent to the incoming class. At that time students will be required to sign a statement that they are able to meet all technical standards of the program. If at any point an instructor (faculty or staff) believes the student is not capable of meeting the standards, the student will be tested by a panel of faculty and staff members. If the student does not meet the required technical skill requirements, the student will be asked to leave the program unless the impairment is deemed temporary. In that case, the student will be asked to drop that particular class or classes and will complete the program with the next incoming class. There is an appeals process that students may pursue. The appeals process can be obtained at the VMT office.
