## **GOALS**

- 1. To provide a professional environment for veterinary students, veterinary technology students and pharmacy externs.
- 2. To provide pharmacy services to patients of the Animal Health Center, to services and programs within the College of Veterinary Medicine, and to other units within the Division of Agriculture, Forestry and Veterinary Medicine.
- 3. To serve as a drug information center.

During normal business hours, drugs and pharmaceutical supplies shall be obtained from the Pharmacy upon completion of a prescription form. Crash carts and emergency supplies are stocked in the Small Animal Clinic, Large Animal Clinic, Surgery and Diagnostic Imaging. Automated Inventory Management dispensers (Cubex) are available for afterhours access and dispensing. Technicians are responsible for restocking crash carts and emergency boxes.
